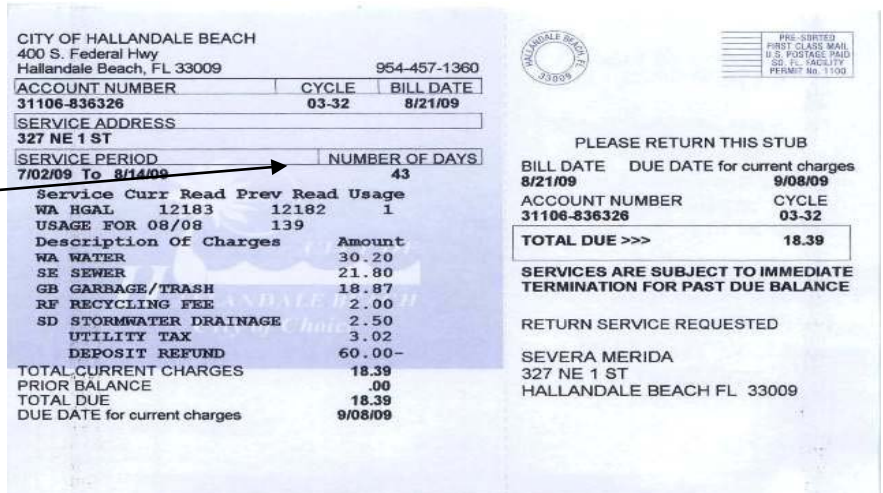


News from the Utility Billing Department

The City of Hallandale Beach utility bill has changed! As of October 2009 the utility bill will be printed on postcards instead of statements. The bills will continue to be mailed monthly containing the same types of charges as the statements (i.e. water, sewer, stormwater, garbage, recycling and utility tax). The City of Hallandale Beach **made this change to save tax payer dollars in the printing and mailing of these bills**. The City worked to make the new utility bill easy to read and understand. SERVICE PERIOD

The time period of usage.

NUMBER OF DAYS

The number of days since the meter was last read.

SERVICE/CURR READ/PREV READ/USAGE

The difference between the current read and the previous read nets the current usage per 100 gallons (HGAL) for the month.

DESCRIPTION OF CHARGES

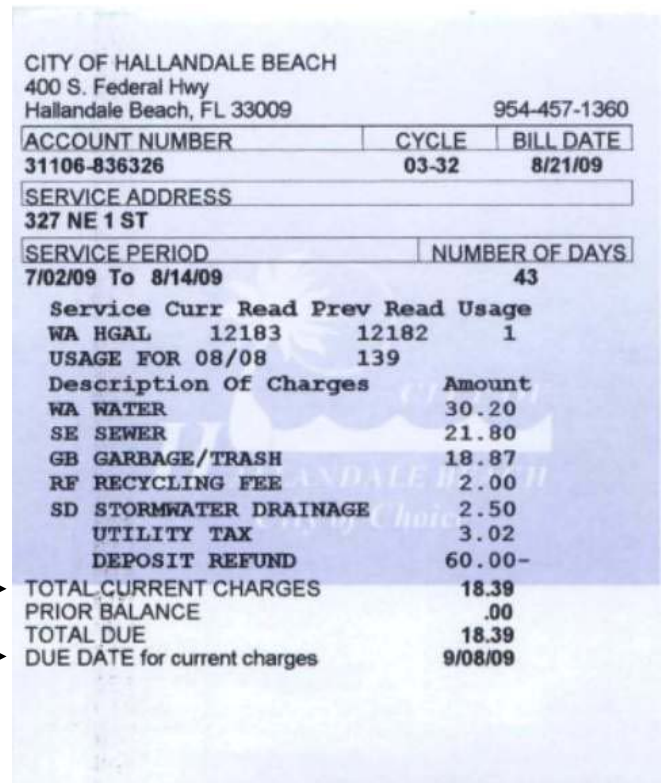
The summary of charges that include the utility tax, actual consumption charges for water and sewer as well as base charges for water (WA), sewer(SE), garbage(GB), stormwater drainage(SD) and recycling(RF).

TOTAL CURRENT CHARGES/PRIOR BALANCE/TOTAL DUE

The amounts that are owed, including any past due balance.

DUE DATE FOR CURRENT CHARGES

The due date for **current** charges only. This date does not include the earlier due date previously provided for the prior balance. The account is subject to termination at any time once the account has two outstanding utility bills.



A 10% late charge is added to accounts paid after the due date and will be applied to the following month's bill
